CHAPTER 307.

Passed Mar. 9, 1846. *An act entitled, a supplement to the act to provide for the inspection of Plaister of Paris in the town of Bladensburg, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter twenty.*

Repealed.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That so much of the act passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter twenty, as limits the inspection of Plaister of Paris to the town of Bladensburg, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that the provisions of said act be and they are extended to, and shall be deemed to embrace the whole of Prince George's county; *and be it further provided,* that nothing in said act or this, to which it is a supplement, shall be taken or construed to authorise the inspectors, appointed in pursuance of this act or the act to which this is a supplement, to inspect any Plaister of Paris, except such as may be sold by the barrel.

Proviso.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the levy court of Prince George's county be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered, if in their judgment they may deem it expedient and necessary, to appoint inspectors of Plaister of Paris, wherever in said county it may be sold or manufactured.

Not apply.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall not apply in cases where the buyer and seller may otherwise agree.

CHAPTER 308.
