SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Not lawful to Maryland, That it shall not be lawful for any person or drive any wapersons to drive any wagon, cart, carriage or other ve-gon, &c. hicle, or to ride or drive any horse or any other large annimal across the bridge over Back creek at Chesapeake City in Cecil county, faster than in a walk, or in any other manner to injure or damage the said bridge.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall not be lawful fast any vessel for any person or persons, to make fast or attach any sail vessel, canal boat, steam boat or any other boat to the said bridge over Back creek in Cecil county, by any rope

or line, or in any other way. SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That any person or per-Injure or damsons who shall in any manner injure or damage the said age bridge bridge over Back creek, or who shall offend against the of not less than provisions of this act, shall be subject to a fine of not less \$20. than one or more than twenty dollars, and shall also be liable for the amount of damage done to the said bridge; the said fine and amount of damages to be recovered on warrant in the name of the State of Maryland, before any justice of the peace in Cecil county; and after defraying the costs of such proceedings, the balance to be paid over by the officer who collects the said fine and damages after deducting five per cent. to the commissioners of Cecil county, to be applied by them to the repairs of the said bridge.
