 Welling academy, one-half of the money which is now  
 paid annually to the Patapsco Female Institute, as a dona-  
 tion from the State in accordance with resolution number  
 thirty-eight of December session, eighteen hundred and  
 thirty-five, as soon as, or whenever the said trustees shall  
 have complied with the laws in relation to schools, acade-  
 mies and colleges receiving donations from this State,  
 and that all acts or parts of acts that are inconsistent with  
 the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby  
 repealed.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted,* That nothing in this act  
 shall be so taken or construed as to allow the said corpo-  
 ration to issue any note, token, scrip or device, to be used  
 as a currency.

SEC. 7. *And be it enacted,* That this act of incorpora-  
 tion shall enure for thirty years from the time of its pas-  
 sage, and that the legislature reserves to itself the right  
 to alter or annul this act of incorporation at pleasure.

CHAPTER 324.

*An act to incorporate a company to make a Turnpike Road*  
*from Caton's Lime Kiln, in Baltimore County, to*  
*Black Rock Mills.*

Passed Mar. 9, 1846.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of*  
*Maryland,* That a company be incorporated to make a  
 turnpike road from Caton's lime kiln in Baltimore county,  
 to Black Rock Mills, to be located by the president and  
 managers that may hereafter be chosen under this act,  
 upon the bed of the road heretofore laid out for that  
 purpose.

Make a turnpike road.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That subscription books  
 be opened for a capital stock of ten thousand dollars in  
 shares of twenty-five dollars each, and that subscriptions  
 be taken at Shawan in said County, under the direction  
 of John T. H. Worthington, John Johns, Doctor Edward  
 Gill, Thomas Lucas and Edward P. Philpot, or any  
 three of them, who are hereby appointed commissioners  
 for the purpose aforesaid, who shall on or before the  
 tenth day of May next, procure books, and in each enter

 scribed, do promise to pay to the president and mana-
