

tees as aforesaid ; and the trustees to be appointed under this act, shall hold office for one year from the time of election as aforesaid and until their successors be elected and qualified.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the trusteeship of the present trustees and their successors, and all their power or possessory right, shall be vacated, cease and determine after the election and qualification of the trustees to be elected under the provisions of this act.

Trusteeship of present trustees to cease after election.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That all acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 343.

*An act to change the name of Margaret E. Gratz to Margaret E. Martin.* Passed Mar. 10, 1846.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the name of Margaret E. Gratz of Baltimore city, be and is hereby changed to Margaret E. Martin, and by that name sue and be sued in any court of law or equity.

Name changed.

CHAPTER 344.

*An act to authorise the Commissioners of Baltimore County to appropriate certain moneys therein mentioned.* Passed Mar. 10, 1846.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That in the event of a sale of any of the property held jointly by the commissioners of Baltimore county and the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, the said commissioners be and they are hereby authorised to apply the proceeds of the county's proportion of such sale to the sinking fund appropriated to the payment of the court house loan.

Commissioners to apply proceeds, &c.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the aforesaid commissioners be and they are hereby authorised to make a like application of any sums which may hereafter be collected or recovered on account of money's due before the first day of January, eighteen hundred and thirty-five, from collectors of the county.
