An act to allow Isaac Scaggs, late Collector of Prince Passed Jan. George's county, further time to complete his collec- 24, 1846.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Time allowed. Maryland, That Isaac Scaggs, late collector of taxes in Prince George's county, be, and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect any and all taxes or balances of taxes now remaining due and uncollected by him in the county aforesaid, in the same manner and with the same privileges and powers he could or might have done within the time limited by law.
