An act to incorporate the town called and known by the Passed March name of Manchester and Germantown, in Carroll 10, 1846. County, under the common name of Manchester.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Incorporated. Maryland, That the citizens of the town commonly called and known by the name of Manchester and Germantown, in Carroll county, shall be and they are hereby constituted and made a body corporate, under the common name of the Commissioners of Manchester, with all the privileges of a body corporate, and to have a com-

mon seal and perpetual succession.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the free male white citizens of Manchester aforesaid, of the age of twenty-commissioners one years and upwards, and who have resided in the said place for and during the space of six months next preceding the election, shall on the first Saturday in April next, and in each and every year thereafter, at the house now occupied as a tavern by William Crumrine, or at such other place as the commissioners thereafter shall direct, to elect five commissioners, who shall each be the proprietors of a house and lot within the limits of said village, and who shall have resided within the limits of the same six months next preceding the election.
