SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Warden and Maryland, That the warden and keepers of the Peniten-ceive. tiary of Maryland be, and they are hereby directed and required to receive into the said penitentiary house, negro man William Wheeler, the slave of Benjamin Contee, lately convicted of the crime of insurrection in Charles county court, and now under sentence of death, in case the Governor of the State in the exercise of the pardoning power in his discretion, and with the assent of said convict, commute the punishment of said convict from death to confinement in the penitentiary for life, any law to the contrary thereof nothwithstanding.
