

Utica Mills, on the road leading from Frederick to Emmitsburg in said county. CHAP. 42.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the levy court aforesaid may, in their discretion, levy the whole or only one half of the aforesaid sum in one year, and when the whole amount may be levied, then the levy court shall appoint three commissioners as a building committee. Discretion of court.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That it shall be the duty of the said commissioners, as soon as they may be appointed and notified of such appointment, to forthwith advertise in the three newspapers in Frederick, known as the Examiner, Citizen, and Herald, at least four weeks before making any contract for the building of said bridge; for sealed proposals for building said bridge, according to the directions in said advertisement, and the commissioners shall, upon the opening of said sealed proposals, make a contract with the party who may have put in the lowest bid, and can give good security for the performance of the contract. Commissioners to advertise.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That any departure from the provisions of the third section of this act shall make void any contract that may be entered into by said commissioners, and shall operate as a repeal of this act, and the levy court shall, in such case, appropriate said sum so levied as aforesaid, to the necessary expenses of the county. Violation of third section—void.

CHAPTER 42.

*An act to provide for the relief of the poor and indigent persons of Somerset county.*

Passed Jan. 27, 1846.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Jehu Parsons, Train Ackworth, Noah Rider, Samuel C. Costen and Samuel S. Boggs, of Somerset county, be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners and they, or a majority of them, shall have full power and authority, and they are hereby directed to contract for, and purchase a farm or parcel of land, in quantity not exceeding six hundred acres, in the name of the trustees of the poor of Somerset county, and their successors, to have and hold the same in trust for the use of the said county; and the said commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby authorised, in their discretion, to erect thereon proper and suitable buildings and Commissioners.
