Resolution in favor of Edward Stewart.

23, 1845.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer pay to Edward Stewart, the sum of fifty-one dollars, it being the amount of his bill for repairing two pieces of ordnance belonging to the State, in the armory at Easton.
