JUDGMENTS AND JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS OF THE COURTS OF JUSTICE OF THIS STATE—The clerk or register of any court of justice, directed forthwith to provide one or more well bound books, and immediately after each term, etc. to enter, etc. the docket entries, etc. ended during the term, etc. entry to contain the name of the party, notice of the case, etc. if superseded the name of superseders, etc. the bills of cost recoverable, etc. likewise to be entered, etc. books to be regularly paged and alphabeted, &c. said clerk or register to receive twenty-five cents for each action, to be taxed in bill of costs against plaintiff, &c.
