Parties to whom licenses may be sold, etc. to make monthly returns on oath to lottery commissioners of the number of tickets sold, etc. at time of return to pay to said commissioners the amount of tax upon the amount of tickets then sold. " 3

Commissioners to keep a record of the number of tickets issued by them, etc. and upon returns made, commissioners to compare said returns with those received, etc. and settle with contractors accordingly, &c. and upon failure to make returns by contractors, bond to be put in suit, &c. " 4

Lottery commissioners to take from contractors bond, &c. " 5
