- NORRIS, ALEXANDER, EX'R. OF JNO. NORRIS—The board of commissioners of Harford, on application of, to issue warrant to sheriff, to summon five discreet men, &c. to meet on a day named in warrant on the location of a public road, &c. and to review the damages formerly allowed, &c. and to proceed, &c. as provided for in act of 1821, ch. 152. 63.
- NORTON, WINFRED—Levy authorised for her support \$25 annually, &c. 168
- NOTARIES PUBLIC—To give bond to State of Maryland before they are authorised to act, to be approved by Governor in the penalty of \$2000 for payment into the treasury of the fees received by them for use of the State, &c. 133 1  
 If any person appointed shall neglect or refuse to give bond within 30 days, Gov. to appoint some other person. " 2
- NOTARY PUBLIC AT EASTON—Tax of State from protest made by said officer released. 345 1  
 To reserve out of cost of protest \$250, if at rate of \$2, it exceed said sum, notary to pay over excess to the Treasurer of Maryland. " 2
