Chap Sec.

PUBLIC REVENUE-Clerks of county courts Howard District and city court of Baltimore, to transmit to treasurer on or before 1st Monday in June and Nov. in each and every year lists and accounts under oath of all licenses granted, etc. lists to conform to directions of the 5th sec. of act of 1831, ch. 262, under the penalty provided by 6th section of act 1827, ch. 117.

- At the time of transmitting said lists, etc. or with 30 days after the said 1st Monday of June and Nov. to pay over, etc. amount appearing by said lists, etc. to be due, and in case of failure to account and pay, etc. within the period aforesaid, treasurer to give notice to deputy attorney general, etc. whose duty it shall be to put bonds in suit, etc. in which recovery shall be had for amount appearing to be due with interest at the rate of ten per cent. from the 1st Monday in June and Nov. respectively, which recovery shall be evidence of misbehaviour and ipso facto remove such clerk, office to be filled by Governor, failure of such clerks to amount to forfeiture of commission, &c.

Duty of registers of wills, register of chancery and clerks of county courts, etc. to account with upon oath and pay over to the treasurer on the 1st Monday, of June and Nov. annually or within 30 days thereafter, all money received by them under the acts of 1844, ch. 184, 187 and 237, to be allowed commission of 5 per cent. upon amount paid over, and in case of failure, etc. within the period, etc. same proceedings, etc. shall ensue as are provided in reference to the clerks, etc. The clerks, &c. and commissioner of loans shall on 1st Mondays of June and Nov. or within 30 days thereafter, account with upon oath and pay to treasurer all sums received under act of 1844, ch. 280, said clerks entitled to deduct therefrom a commission of five per cent, and in case of fail-

ure in addition to the proceedings, recov-
