SLAVES—If any slave convicted of the crime of murder in second degree or accessory thereto, or of manslaughter or rape, or accessory before the fact, or of carnally knowing a woman child, when under 10 years of age, or of assault with intent to murder, rob or commit rape, &c. or of conspiring, &c. to raise insurrection, &c. or of burglary, &c. or of arson, &c. such slave to be punished as all other persons now are for like offences, etc.
