ST. MARY'S COUNTY—Whenever application is made for the admission of any child, etc. in the school in his district, etc. and the child is refused without the payment of the sum assessed upon admission, etc. the parent and trustees, each to appoint an arbitrator, etc. to say whether the parent is able to pay, etc. if they determine the parties are not able, then trustees to admit, etc. and upon refusal and representation made to commissioners of school district, trustees so refusing to comply, debarred all benefit of State's donation, until grievance is remedied.

STOCK BROKERS, &c.—The sheriff of each county, etc. shall annually, in the month of April, make, etc. a list of all individuals who make it a business to deal in the purchase or sale of stocks, etc. and return said list, etc. to clerk of the court where such individuals procure license, sheriff to be compensated as provided by 5th section of act of 1827, ch. 117, etc.

Sheriff to appear, etc. before the grand jury, etc. and point out the names of persons who have failed to comply, etc.

The whole of the penalty, etc. upon conviction, shall enure to benefit of sheriff, etc. who is a competent witness, etc.
