Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, the acknowledgment of the deed from Daniel Repp and wife to Leonard Reddick, recorded amongst the land records of Frederick county, in Liber J. S. No. 41, folios 373, 374, and 375, which said acknowledgment appears to have been taken in the State of Ohio before two justices of the peace of said State, be and the same is hereby ratified, and made valid, as much so as if said acknowledgment had been made in conformity to the laws regulating acknowledgments of deeds made out of the State of Maryland.
