An additional supplement to the act relating to the Maryland Penitentiary, passed at December session eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, chapter three hundred and twenty.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Repealed. Maryland, That so much of section five, of the act of eighteen hundred and thirty-seven, chapter three hundred and twenty, and of the rules and regulations established thereby, prohibiting the employment of convicts and forbidding their entrance into the front building of the penitentiary, be and the same is hereby repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the directors of the Salaries of offipenitentiary may authorise the payment in whole or in cers paid in part, of the salaries and dues of the several officers and whole or in others officially connected with the institution, in the goods, work or manufactures of the penitentiary.
