SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the employment, by Punishable by any licensed vendor or vendors, or any other person, of fine, &c. . any negro or colored person, to do any of the matters or things prohibited by this act, or in any way to assist in doing them, shall be punishable upon indictment and conviction thereof, by a fine of not less than fifty, nor more than two hundred and fifty dollars, and by imprisonment for not less than twenty days, nor more than six months.

SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That, in case any person Duty of comlicensed by the commissioners of lotteries to sell domestic annul license. lottery tickets, shall commit any of the offences mentioned in this act, it shall be the duty of said commissioners forthwith to annul his license or any license in which he may be interested, in addition to which, he shall be liable to be prosecuted as is by this act provided; and it shall also be the duty of said commissioners to issue to the contractors to whom said license shall have been originally granted, another license for the unexpired term thereof without charge.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That no proceeding in any No proceeding court or before any justice by indictment, action of debt, &c. set aside bill in equity, or otherwise instituted, upon the sugges- in form. tion of the commissioners of lotteries shall be quashed, set aside, dismissed or delayed for any defect or form whatsoever.
