Watkins, Alexander Baltzell, Samuel Thomas and William Sullivan, and such other persons as are now, or may hereafter become members, shall be, and they are hereby created and made a body politic and corporate, by the name, style and title of the Wesley Chapel Parsonage Library Association of Baltimore, and by that name shall have continued succession, plead and be impleaded, defend and be defended in any court of law or equity in this State, or elsewhere, and to make, have and use a common seal, and the same to alter or renew at their pleasure.
