CHAPTER 126.

Passed Feb
26, 1847. *An act to change the name of Sarah Ann Post, to that of Sally Ann Post Fectig.*

Repealed.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the name of Sarah Ann Post, of Washington county, daughter of George Fectig be, and the same is hereby changed to that of Sally Ann Post Fectig; and that the act of December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter two hundred and ninety-three, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 127.

13, 1847. *An act for the incorporation of the Frostburg Lodge Number Forty-Nine, of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, of the State of Maryland.*

Incorporated.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Edward L. Thomas, A. G. Slicer, N. B. Long, Jacob Hoblitzell, William B. Shaw, John J. Keller, Daniel C. Bruce, Daniel Sease, J. S. Welch and Thomas H. Frost, the officers and members of the Frostburg Lodge Number Forty-Nine, of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of Maryland, and their successors be, and they are hereby declared to be a community, corporation and body politic, by the name, style and title of the Frostburg Lodge Number Forty-Nine, of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows of the State of Maryland, and by that name, they and their successors shall and may at all times hereafter be capable in law to have, receive and retain to them and their successors, property, real and personal, and also devises or bequests of any person or persons, body politic or corporate, capable of making the same; and the same, at their pleasure, to transfer or dispose of in such manner as they may think proper; *provided always,* that the said corporation or body politic shall not at any time hold or possess property, real, personal or mixed, exceeding in annual value the sum of five thousand dollars.
