CHAPTER 16.

An act to incorporate the Washington Division Number Passed Jan. Nine, of the Order of the Sons of Temperance.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Incorporated, Maryland, That John Green, Jr., William G. Young, William A. Disney, Samuel Henderson, Amasa Leonard, Jr., John J. Hindes, Charles F. Bevan, William Sullivan, Edward May, Edward Cockey and others, the officers and members of the Washington Division Number Nine, of the Order of the Sons of Temperance, and their successors be, and they are hereby declared to be a community, corporation and body politic, by the name and number, style and title of the Washington Division Number Nine, of the Order of the Sons of Temperance, and by that name and number, they and their successors shall and may, at any time hereafter, be capable in law to have, receive and retain to them and their successors, property, real and personal; also devises or bequests of any person or persons, bodies corporate or politic, capable of making the same, and the same at their pleasure to transfer or dispose of in such manner as they may think proper; provided, always, that the said corporation or body politic, shall not at any time hold or possess property, real, personal or mixed, exceeding in value the sum of twenty thousand dollars.
