Be it enacted by the General Assembly of make return to Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, it shall be the duty of the levy courts or county commissioners of the several counties and of Howard District of this State, and of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, to inquire into, and make return to the Governor of this State, on the first Monday in May annually, of the names of all the blind white persons of sound mind, in their respective counties, district and city, who are in indigent circumstances or whose private fortunes, in the opinion of said levy courts or commissioners for said counties or Howard District, or Mayor and Council of Baltimore, are insufficient to afford them an opportunity of removing to some suitable and convenient institution for the education of the blind to be there educated.
