CHAPTER 137.

Passed Feb. 23, 1847.

A supplement to an act entitled, an act for the relief of Samuel P. Smith and Reuben Worthington, of Allegany County, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-three, chapter thirty-two.

May collect.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, it shall and may be lawful for Margaret A. McKinley, of Allegany county, to collect from Samuel P. Smith and Reuben Worthington, in quarterly instalments, the amount of annuity allowed her, from time to time, under the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement.

CHAPTER 138.

Passed Feb 27, 1847.

An act to incorporate the Roxbury Manufacturing Company.

Incorporated.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Allen Bowie Davis, William L. Gaither, John Glenn, Remus Riggs, and their associates, successors and assigns be, and they are hereby created a corporation and body politic, by the name and title of the Roxbury Manufacturing Company, and by that name may have perpetual succession, and shall be able and capable in law, to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered in any court of law or equity, and make and use a common seal, and to ordain and establish such by-laws and regulations, and alter or amend the same, as shall be necessary or convenient for conducting the affairs of the corporation not repugnant to law.*

Objects of corporation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted, That the objects of the said corporation are declared to be the making, and manufacturing, and trading in flour, cotton, wool and other articles, for which purpose they are hereby authorised to purchase, hold, and dispose of mixed property or*
