And be it enacted, That, for the management of the affairs of the company, the stockholders, or a majority of them, shall elect a president and not less than four directors, who shall remain in office for one year, or until successors shall be elected, a majority of whom shall form a quorum or board; that a majority of stockholders shall at any time call a meeting, upon advising all the stockholders, by advertisement, or otherwise, of the time and place of holding said meeting.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That the stock of said Stock deemed company shall be deemed personal estate, and that all personal estate the property, estate and joint stock of the corporation

shall be bound and answerable for its debts and liabilities. SEC. 5. And be it enacted, That nothing contained herein, shall be construed as granting banking privileges to the said corporation, or exempting their property from general taxation.

SEC. 6. And be it enacted, That the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter or annul this act of in-wed. corporation whenever the public interest may require it.
