Passed Feb. An act to lay out and open a Road through a part of Fre-27, 18 7. derick and Montgomery Counties.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of commissioners Maryland, That the levy court of Frederick county, and the commissioners for Montgomery county, are hereby authorised and empowered, if in their opinion it be expedient and promotive of the public convenience to appoint three commissioners; the levy court of Frederick county to appoint one, and the commissioners for Montgomery county the other two, to have, or cause to have surveyed and opened a road commencing on the south side of Survey and Sheckel's branch, where it crosses the road leading from Damascus to Clarksburg, in Montgomery county, and running from thence, the most convenient and advantage-

ous route to cross Bennet's creek, at the present ford near John Boyer's mill, thence to Bethesda church, and

thence to intersect the road leading from Hyattstown to
