SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the expense of sur- Expenses—

 veying and opening the said road, shall be paid by the  
 aforesaid counties, according to the expense incurred in  
 each county, and the levy court of Frederick county, and  
 the commissioners for Montgomery county, are hereby  
 authorised to levy on the assessable property of said  
 counties, the sum necessary to defray the expense of  
 surveying and opening the said road in each county, to  
 be collected as other county charges are, and the said  
 road when so opened, shall be kept in repair as other  
 public roads are.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the said commission- Value and as-

 ers, or a majority of them, shall value and ascertain the  
 damages that may be sustained by any person or persons  
 through whose land the said road may pass, taking into  
 consideration the advantages and disadvantages, if any,  
 and the said damages to be levied, assessed, collected

CHAPTER 162.

*A further supplement to the several acts relating to the* Passed Feb.  
27, 1847.  
*Commissioners of Baltimore County.*

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of* Not eligible.  
*Maryland,* That no person shall be eligible to the office  
 of commissioner of Baltimore county, who has already  
 been, or may hereafter be elected for two successive  
 terms, until he shall have been out of office for at least  
 two years.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That no commissioner No commis-

 of commissioners of Baltimore county, during the term  
 for which he has been elected to office.
