SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the last day of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, Dec. 1848. that Charles G. Haslup, one of the late collectors of county and States' taxes in Howard District, in Anne Arundel county, for the years eighteen hundred and forty-three and eighteen hundred and forty-four, by himself, or any person or persons appointed for this purpose be, and are hereby authorised and empowered to collect until the last day of December, eighteen hundred and fortyeight, all sums and balances due him as collector of county and State taxes in Howard District, in Anne Arundel county, in the same manner which he, the said Charles G. Haslup, could or might have done within the time limited by law, anything to the contrary notwithstanding; provided, that before the aforesaid Charles G. Proviso.
