SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Orphans court Maryland, That the orphans court of Caroline county commissioners are hereby authorised to appoint three persons as commissioners, whose duty it shall be forthwith to proceed to lay out and locate a primary school district, to be called the Boonsborough Primary School District, composed of parts of election districts number one and two, of the county aforesaid; a description of the bounds of which shall be made out, in writing, and signed by said commissioners, and filed with the orphans court aforesaid, which shall be sufficient evidence of said school
