And be it enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the said corporation to have a common seal for their use, and the same at their will and pleasure to change, alter or make anew from time to time, as they may think best, and shall in general have and exercise all such rights, privileges and immunities, as by law are incident or necessary to corporations, and which may be necessary to the corporation herein constituted, and to enable the members of said order to exercise all things concening the designs of this corporation, for the benevolent relief of the sick and distressed, and for the promotion of their purposes generally.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this corporation shall May alter byhave power to alter and amend their by-laws at pleasure; provided, such alterations or amendment shall not conflict Proviso. or be inconsistent with the constitution and laws of the United States, or of the State of Maryland, or of the Grand Division of the Order of the Sons of Temperance.
