CHAPTER 329. CHAPTER 330

An act to authorise Thomas M. D. Baden, former Col-Passed March lector of Prince George's County, further time to 10, 1847. complete his collections.

SECTION 1. Fe it enacted by the General Assembly of Authorised to Maryland, That Thomas M. D. Baden, former collector collect. of Prince George's county be, and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect any tax, or balances of taxes, now remaining due and uncollected by him, in the same manner as he could or might have done within the time limited by law.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said Thomas M. D. Baden, before he proceeds to execute the property of days notice. any person, by the authority of this act, shall deliver, or cause to be delivered, to the person or persons chargeable with the same, and at least ten days before he shall proceed to execute as aforesaid, a particular account of the sum demanded of him, her or them, with an affidavit thereto annexed, that he hath not, nor hath any person acting under him, whilst collector as aforesaid, or since then, received any part thereof or satisfaction for the same, to the best of his knowledge and belief; provided, Proviso. that nothing in this act contained, shall be so construed as to effect the estate of a deceased person, except to authorise the said Thomas M. D. Baden to recover any claim or balance due by a deceased person, in the same manner that claims against deceased persons are now

recovered by law. SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this law shall be in In force one force one year from the passage thereof, and no longer. year.
