An act to incorporate a Company to make a Turnpike Passed March Road from Hagerstown, in Washington County, to the 10, 1847. Pennsylvania line.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Incorporated. Maryland, That Joseph Gabby, Frederick Zeigler, Abraham Strete, Lewis Zeigler, John Mentzer, Frederick Dorsey, and all other persons who may have subscribed, or may hereafter subscribe to the stock of said company be, and they are hereby incorporated a body politic, for making a turnpike road, to be commenced at some point within the corporate limits of the town of Hagerstown, and extended to the Pennsylvania line, in the direction of Waynesborough through the town of Leitersburg.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the capital stock of Capital not to said company shall not exceed thirty thousand dollars, to exceed 30,000 be divided into shares of twenty-five dollars each, and
