An act to provide for the Inspection of Guano in the City Passed March 10, 1847. of Baltimore.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Governor to Maryland, That the Governor, with the advice and con-appoint an insent of the State, shall, after the passage of this act, and spector. before the first day of May next, and in every year thereafter appoint a practical chemist of integrity and good character, as inspector of Guano in the city of Balti-

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said inspector of Make oath. guano so appointed, before he enters upon the execution of the duties of his office, shall make the following oath or affirmation before the Mayor, or some justice of the peace in the city of Baltimore: I do solemnly swear, or affirm, as the case may be, that I will faithfally, truly, and impartially execute the duties imposed upon me by law, as inspector of guano, to the best of my judgment and understanding, and that I will not buy, trade or barter, or be concerned directly or indirectly, in buying, trading or bartering for any guano in the city of Baltimore, whilst an inspector thereof, so help me God.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That from and after the passage of this act, it shall not be lawful to sell, expose or offer for sale, any guano within the limits of the city
