A supplement to an act passed at December session, eighteen Passed March hundred and thirty-one, chapter two hundred and fortyfour, so far as relates to Election District Number Two, in Caroline County.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of and divide dis-Muryland, That Samuel Dunning, James Hignutt and James trict. Carter, of Caroline county be, and they are hereby appointed commissioners, and they, or a majority of them, shall have full power and authority to lay out and divide election district number two, in school districts, of not greater dimensions than equal to a space of six miles square, regulating the size and boundary lines of said districts by natural objects, roads and local circumstances, as in the opinion of said commissioners shall be most beneficial and convenient for the inhabitants of the several districts.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That said commissioners, When district when they shall so have divided the said district into school districts school districts, shall cause a return to be drawn up, in a return to be writing, in a book provided for that purpose, signed by drawn up. said commissioners, or a majority of them, describing particularly and distinctly the limits of said districts, and designating them respectively by numbers, from one in progressive succession, and shall lodge said return with the register of wills of the county, whose duty it shall be to file the same with the papers relating to schools in
