CHAP. 358, aforesaid, without a license first had and obtained as hereinbefore provided, he, she or they shall forfeit and pay for each offence the sum of three hundred dollars, one-half to the use of the informer, who shall be a competent witness, the other half to be paid to the clerk of the county court, or of Howard District court, or of the city court of Baltimore, as the case may be, for the use of this State, to be recovered in the name of the State of Maryland, by action of debt or indictment in the county court, or Howard District court, or the city court of Baltimore, where such offence shall have been committed, and to be accounted for and paid into the treasury by the clerk receiving the same, at the period limited for accounting for and paying monies received for licenses as aforesaid.
