

**CHAP. 358.** aforesaid, without a license first had and obtained as hereinbefore provided, he, she or they shall forfeit and pay for each offence the sum of three hundred dollars, one-half to the use of the informer, who shall be a competent witness, the other half to be paid to the clerk of the county court, or of Howard District court, or of the city court of Baltimore, as the case may be, for the use of this State, to be recovered in the name of the State of Maryland, by action of debt or indictment in the county court, or Howard District court, or the city court of Baltimore, where such offence shall have been committed, and to be accounted for and paid into the treasury by the clerk receiving the same, at the period limited for accounting for and paying monies received for licenses as aforesaid.

Treasurer to publish annually.

**SEC. 7.** *And be it enacted,* That the treasurer shall annually publish in at least two newspapers, one of which shall be in the city of Baltimore, the names of such agent or agents so taking out licenses under this act, with the names of the companies they represent.

Agents not to act for more than one foreign corporation, &c.

**SEC. 8.** *And be it enacted,* That nothing in this act contained, shall authorise any agent or agents to act as such for more than one foreign corporation, individual, or association of individuals, by virtue of one license.

Repealed.

**SEC. 9.** *And be it enacted,* That the acts of December session, eighteen hundred and thirty-nine, chapter twenty-four, and of December session, eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter one hundred and sixty-seven be, and the same are hereby repealed, but all rights acquired by the State under said acts are hereby expressly reserved.

Passed March 10, 1847.

*An act for the benefit of the Baltimore Manual Labor School for Indigent Boys.*

Commissioners to pay over \$500.

**SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the tax commissioners of Baltimore county, are hereby authorised and directed to pay to the treasurer of the Baltimore Manual Labor School for Indigent Boys, the sum of five hundred dollars, out of the monies received by them from the school fund.
