CITIZENS' BANK OF BALTIMORE—Whenever the requisitions of the third section of act of 1844, chapter 110, shall have been complied with by, bank to resume banking business when paid in, as a part of its capital, fifty thousand dollars in specie. 245 1

Upon the day when the bank shall resume, president to certify the same to treasurer, under seal of the bank, and bank, from date of certificate, liable for payment of school tax. " 2

No person to be eligible as director who does not hold one hundred shares, &c., nor remain in after he ceases to be holder of such number, but with such qualification any stockholder eligible. " 3

All parts of original act and supplements as are inconsistent repealed. " 4

CITY OF BALTIMORE—See *Baltimore City*.

CIVIL CASES—After passage of this act, not lawful to arrest and hold to bail, on mesne process, any person, a non-resident, &c., for debt contracted within this State. 360

Non-resident so arrested may apply in writing to the judges, &c., setting forth he is a non-resident, &c., and on proof, &c., judges to discharge, &c.

Non-resident so arrested, may have the fact of non-residence inquired into, and the fact of place of contract decided before return day of suit, &c. " 3

This act not to affect the law of attachment. " 4
