Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of insolvent debtors for the city and county of Baltimore, or any justice of the orphans add of all court of any county, or judge of any court in this State, authorised to grant discharges under the insolvent laws now in force be, and they are hereby authorised to grant unto John S. Skinner, a former resident of Maryland, the benefit of the several acts of the Assembly for the relief of insolvent debtors; provided, the said John S.
