TENANTS FOR YEARS OR AT WILL—In all cases of tenancies in the city of Baltimore, a justice of the peace, on complaint, &c.; and on summons to tenant, &c., may exercise all the powers granted to two justices and the jury by the act to which this is a supplement, and the supplement passed 1831, chapter 318. 217 1
