**TRUSTEES AND RECEIVERS**—The supplement of act of 1845, ch. 166, imposing a tax on commissions allowed to, not to extend to trustees appointed to preserve contingent remainders, or where trustee is interposed to preserve title; and in cases where the trust is subject to disposition of trustee only, upon the happening of a contingency, no bond required until contingencies occur. 153 1  
 In any case where application is made to chancellor or county courts, &c, they may prescribe the amount of the bond included in the terms of said act, &c. “ 2
