 sors be, and they are hereby incorporated and made a
 body politic and corporate by the name and number of
 Boone Division Number Thirty-three of the Sons of
 Temperance of the State of Maryland, and by that name,
 may sue and be sued, and have a common seal, and the
 same at their pleasure to alter, and be entitled to use the
 powers and privileges incident to such corporation.

CHAP. 57.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said corporation
 shall be capable in law of taking and holding real and
 personal estate; also devises or bequest of any person or
 persons, bodies corporate or politic, capable of making
 the same, and the same at their pleasure to transfer or
 dispose of in such manner as they may think proper;
provided, that the said corporation or body politic, shall
 not at any one time hold or possess property, real, perso-
 nal or mixed, exceeding in value the sum of five thousand
 dollars.

May hold real and personal estate.

Proviso.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this corporation shall
 have power to make, alter and amend their by-laws at
 pleasure; *provided*, they do not conflict with the laws of
 the United States, or the laws of the State of Mary-
 land.

May alter and amend their by-laws.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this corporation shall
 not be permitted to issue any note, token, device, scrip
 or other evidence of debt, to be used as a currency.

Issues forbid.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act of incorpora-
 tion shall enure for thirty years from its passage, and that
 the Legislature reserves to itself the right to alter or an-
 nul this act of incorporation at pleasure.

Enure for 30 years.

CHAPTER 57.

*An act to change the names of Sarah E. F. Hopkins, Ada
 Hopkins and Josephine Hopkins, of the City of Bal-
 timore.* Passed Feb. 17, 1847.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,
 That from and after the passage of this act, the names be changed.
