CHAPTER 101.

Passed Feb. 23, 1847. *An act to incorporate the Trustees of East Nottingham School Association in Cecil County.*

Incorporated. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That William P. Jones, David B. Trimble, and Joseph Haines, trustees for a school erected in Cecil county, named the East Nottingham School Association, and their successors to be hereinafter directed, shall from the passage of this act, be and they are hereby created, established and declared to be one body politic and corporate, by the name, style and title of the East Nottingham School Association in Cecil county, by which name and title the said trustees and their successors shall be capable in law and equity to hold property whether acquired by purchase, gift or devise, property real, personal or mixed; provided, it does not exceed at any time two thousand dollars in value.*

Name, style and title.

Proviso.

Meeting of the subscribers.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted, That the trustees for the time being, shall call a meeting of the subscribers of said school association on the first day of March, eighteen hundred and forty-seven, and on the same day in each and every succeeding year, or within thirty days thereafter, for the purpose of electing three trustees, to be chosen by and amongst the subscribers, for the management of said school for one year from the day of said election, and the trustees herein appointed, and who shall hereafter be elected, shall be entitled to hold their office until a new election shall be made, they shall have power to fill all vacancies which shall occur in their own body until the annual election, and to take and use all legal and proper measures for the improvement and preservation of the school aforesaid.*

Books to be kept for the use of the corporation.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted, That the trustees shall keep a book or books, or cause to be kept a book or books, for the use of said corporation, in which shall be duly entered all the subscriptions to the use of the corporate objects, and other proceedings of said corporation to which entries of subscription, each subscriber's name shall be entered, and which with proof of payment, shall be evidence of a right to vote as a member of the corporation, and the proceedings of the trustees, and all other matters authorised by this act, may be regulated by a majority of the members assembled at any annual meeting, and notice of said meeting be given in such manner as the trustees shall direct, and no person shall*
