

CHAP. 153. advice and consent of the Senate, shall be authorised to appoint one assistant flour inspector for the city of Baltimore, in addition to the number already allowed by law, who shall be subject to the rules, regulations and laws that are now in force and applicable to inspectors of flour in said city, and shall receive compensation for his services in like manner as is now provided by law for said inspectors.

Inconsistent acts repealed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted,* That all acts or parts of acts of Assembly, inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 152.

Passed Feb. 29, 1848.

An act to authorise the Commissioners of Harford County to build a bridge over Deer Creek, at Hookers Saw Mill.

Levy authorised to build bridge.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Harford county be, and they are hereby authorised, if in their discretion they deem it expedient, to build a bridge over Deer creek, at Hookers saw mill in said county, and to levy therefor any sum not exceeding six hundred dollars.

CHAPTER 153.

Passed Feb. 29, 1848.

An act for the relief of Tabitha Knight, of Harford County.

Levy authorised for her support.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the commissioners of Harford county, be and they are hereby authorised and directed to levy annually upon the assessable property of Harford county, the sum of twenty-five dollars for the use and maintenance of said Tabitha Knight, and payable to her order.
