

direct and authorise the agent of the school fund of said county to pay over to the proper parties entitled to receive the value of the said land and damages, as may be assessed, and shall further order the report of the persons appointed as aforesaid with their approval thereof to be recorded by the clerk of Worcester county court among the land records of said county.

Sec. 9. *And be it further enacted,* That all acts heretofore passed inconsistent with the provisions of this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 173.

An act to incorporate a Company to make a Turnpike Road from Weaverton to Boonsborough, in Washington County.

Passed
March 2, 1848.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Casper W. Weaver, Edward Garrott, Emory Edwards, John Grim, Junior, Frederick Rhorer, Elias Davis, John Horine, Josiah Snively and Robert Fowler, and all other persons who may have subscribed or may hereafter subscribe to the stock of said company, be and they are hereby incorporated a body politic, for making a turnpike road, to be commenced at Weaverton, and running thence through the towns of Brownsville and Rhorer'sville to the town of Boonsborough, in Washington county, following the bed of the old road as far as practicable.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the capital stock of said company shall not exceed fifty thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of twenty dollars each, and as soon as subscribers to said stock amounting to the sum of ten thousand dollars are obtained, a majority so subscribing shall give three weeks publication in one or more newspapers published in Hagerstown, the time and place designated by them for the stockholders in said company to meet for the purpose of organizing said corporation, choosing by a plurality of votes by ballot a president and five managers, three of whom shall constitute a quorum, and they shall select in the same manner by ballot a treasurer and such other officers as they shall deem necessary for conducting the affairs of said company until the first Monday in November thereafter, and until a new election shall be held, which said election shall be held
