SEC. 9. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty commission of the board of school commissioners to furnish all such books, &c. and necessary books and stationary for the pupils of the said each pupil to school, and in general whatever fuel or other supplies pay in advance the school may require, to be paid for from the public \$1 per quarter school fund, and each pupil shall pay in advance a sum not exceeding one dollar per quarter, and the same advance of payment for each quarter shall be required during the continuance of such pupil in the schools, unless exempted therefrom by said board of school commissioners.
