*A supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Southern Packet Company.*

Capital stock  
to be increased

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Baltimore and Southern Packet Company, shall be and are hereby authorised to increase the capital stock of said company to two hundred and fifty thousand dollars, by new subscriptions or by adding to the said capital semi-annually a portion of their net profits not otherwise appropriated, whenever it shall be so determined by the board of directors.*

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted, That so much of the second section of the act to which this is a supplement, passed at December session eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter two hundred and fifty-two, as limits the capital stock of said company to one hundred thousand dollars, be and the same is hereby repealed.*

*An act for the benefit of William H. Hooper, of the City of Baltimore.*

May have benefit  
of insolvent  
laws.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That William H. Hooper, of the city of Baltimore, upon his application to the commissioners of insolvent debtors for Baltimore city and county, be and he is hereby entitled to all the benefits of the insolvent laws of this State notwithstanding his application for the benefit of the insolvent laws of Maryland within the last two years; provided, in all other respects he shall in all other respects comply with the provisions of the said insolvent laws.*
