An act to authorise the Commissioners of Talbot county Passed to levy a sum of money to aid in the purchase of a fire Mar. 10, 1848. engine and apparatus, for the protection of the property of the county and of the citizens of Easton.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Levy authoris-Maryland, That the commissioners of Talbot county be ed to purchase and they are hereby authorised, empowered and required fire engine, to levy upon the assessable property of the county a sum of money, in their discretion, not exceeding two hundred dollars, to aid in the purchase of a fire engine and necessary apparatus for the protection of the property of the county and the citizens of the town of Easton.
