CHAP. 285, and an half per centum thereof; to the fifth election district, Dublin, nineteen and an half per centum thereof; to the sixth election district, Havre de Grace, ten and

an half per centum thereof.

To whom to be paid.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the said court shall pay to the commissioners to be appointed for each district as hereinafter stated the sum to which such district may be entitled, and it shall be the duty of said commissioners to apply said money in paying for the teaching of such poor children of their districts, not under six years of age, as may from the condition of their parents, guardians or otherwise, require the aid of the school fund.

SEC. 3.
