An act to incorporate the Philadelphia Mining Company. Passed Mar, 10, 1848.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Incorporated. Maryland, That Matthew Topham Evans, William M. F. Magraw, Thomas Johnson Evans, Thomas J. Johnson and all and every person who shall become associated with them in the manner hereinafter prescribed, shall be and they are hereby incorporated by the name of the Philadelphia Mining company, and as style. such shall have succession, and may have and use a common seal, and be able and capable to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded in any court of law or equity, and may have, use, exercise and enjoy all to the the powers, privileges and rights proper and necessary for carrying on the mining of coal, and for opening, working and vending the produce of their lands and mines, and shall have power to take, purchase and hold all such property, real, personal or mixed that they may require for the purposes aforesaid, and shall have power to make and enter into all manner of contracts in relation to the business and property aforesaid; provided, Proviso. that the said corporation shall at no time hold or possess in this State more than five thousand acres of land, ex-
