SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the inhabitants of said district shall be in all respects entitled to all the rights, liberties and privileges, held or to be held and enjoyed by the other election districts in said county. Entitled to all rights of the other districts.

CHAPTER 53.

A supplement to an act entitled, an act establishing a Library for the use of the Legislature, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and twenty six, chapter fifty-three. Passed
Jan. 28, 1848.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That from and after the passage of this act, some qualified person shall be appointed by the concurrent vote of the Senate and House of Delegates of this State as Librarian, who previous to entering upon the duties of his office, shall give bond to the State of Maryland, in such sum and with such security as the committees of the said Senate and House on the library approve, with condition as prescribed in the third section of the act to which this is a supplement. Mode of appointment of the Librarian changed.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That in case of the death, disqualification, resignation or removal from the State of the librarian, during the recess of the General Assembly, the Governor of the State shall fill such vacancy, and the person so appointed shall continue in office until the next meeting of the General Assembly, giving bond and security as aforesaid, to be approved of by the Governor. Vacancy—how to be filled

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That any librarian hereafter appointed, shall continue in office until a successor shall be appointed as aforesaid. Term of office.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That so much of the original act to which this is a supplement, as is inconsistent with this act, shall be and the same is hereby repealed. Inconsistent acts repealed.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That the librarian shall hereafter be charged with the general superintendence and care of the public buildings and grounds within the State House circle. To have the charge of public buildings and grounds.
