*Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the State, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Philip Pasterfield, of Talbot county, the surviving brother and legal representative of Sarah Auld, the widow of Daniel Auld, a soldier of the revolutionary war, or to his order, the balance of any pension due on the books of the treasury to Sarah Auld, on the twenty-eighth day of June last, at the time of her death.*
